Giving and Receiving Constructive Feedback

То	Students might say
Show appreciation for a comment	"Your explanation gives me the details I needed to understand better."
	"I didn't realize that. Now I see why"
Ask for clarification of a comment or question	"I didn't understand what you said. Can you please reword it?" "I want to make sure I understand your question. Were you asking if?"
Agree with a comment	"I agree with your point because [give a reason or evidence]." "I find what you said convincing because [give a reason or evidence]."
Agree with and add on to a comment	"Also, I read that" "I'd like to build on what you said by adding my observation that"
Disagree with a comment	"I disagree because [give a reason or evidence]." "I understand why you think, but I disagree because [give a reason or evidence]."
Partly agree and partly disagree with a comment	"I agree that, but I disagree that" "I think is right, but I think is incorrect because [give a reason or evidence]."
Respond to a disagreement	"I hadn't thought about that. I think you're right." "I see your point, but I'm going to stick to my position because [give a reason or evidence]."
Pull the group back when it's going off topic	"I think we're getting off topic. Let's try to get back to the question we're trying to answer." "That's really interesting, but right now, we should be talking about"
