Consultant Observation and Feedback Visit

The *Responsive Classroom* package is designed to support on-going and embedded professional development through the *RC Improvement Cycle* process. The process begins with a RC consultant visiting your school approximately 4-9 weeks after implementation has started upon completion of the four-day course. The consultant conducts an *Inventory of RC Practices*, by observing a representative population (10) of the 30 teachers who completed the course and non-classroom spaces such as cafeteria, hallways, gym and playground. At the end of the observation, the school leader receives a *School Profile Summary* in PDF format. This summary offers easy to interpret color-coded data and a description of the phase of growth the school is in. The report also includes a list of resources specifically selected to support teacher practice. The school leader will have access to the Inventory of Practice tool to complete 2 more observations on their own and continue the RC Improvement Cycle.
