

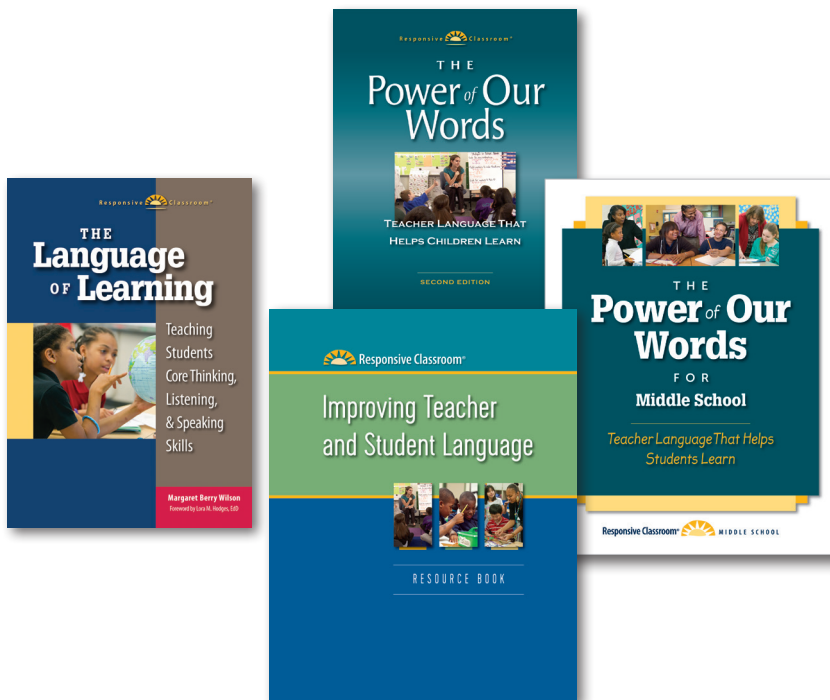
Improving Teacher and Student Language Workshop
