

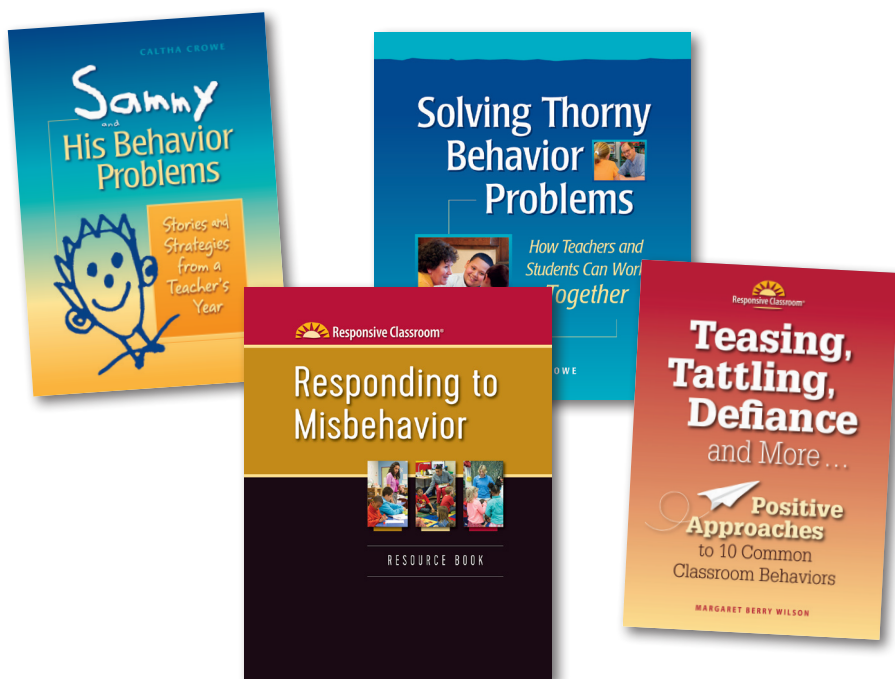
Responding to Misbehavior Workshop
