

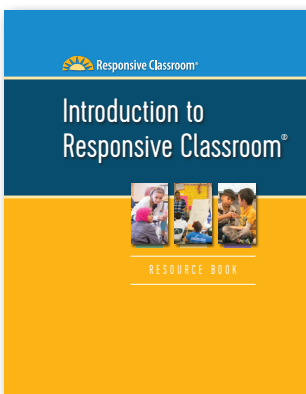
Introduction to Responsive Classroom Workshop
