Materials

Purple Soup

How to do it

1 As the children sit and listen, stand and sing/chant to them.

We're making purple soup! (put hands together, move as if stirring)

Whip, whip . . . whip, whip (put hands on hips, wiggle right to left)

We're making purple soup! (put hands together, move as if stirring)

Shooby dooby do (point fingers up, twirl around)

With purple potatoes (stretch one fist out)

And purple tomatoes (stretch opposite fist out, place on top of other fist)

And we . . . (point thumbs at shoulders)

Want . . . (move hands away from shoulders with palms up)

YOU! (point to another person to join in)

- When you point to a child on YOU!, that child stands and joins you in singing/chanting. Keep pointing to someone new on YOU! until the whole group is standing and singing/chanting.
- **T**o end, change the last three lines to:

And we're . . .

All . . .

DONE! . . . YUM! (rub tummies)

Tips for Success

- * Model the motions for each line and using an appropriate voice volume (especially on YOU!).
- * After some practice, invite students to substitute a different color and other moves.
