One-day advanced workshop

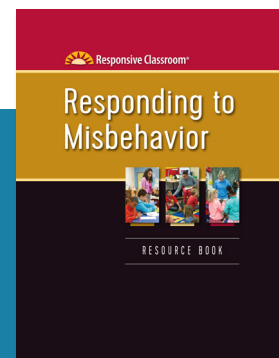
Suitable for educators of grades pre-K–6
